CLASSROOM RULES

DAILY STARTERS: 5 points daily

- Daily starters cannot be made up unless it is an excused absence or school excused tardy.
 - Each student is allowed 3 excused absences before a make-up plan is necessary
 - Two "0" score starters can be dropped at the end of the term
 - Medical, school activities, and pre-excused absences do not count against your grade.
- If a student is tardy to class they will not receive full points for the starter
- If a student is later than 30 minutes he/she will forfeit Starter points for the day.

CLASS PARTICIPATION: 5 points daily for work in class

- No points given for unexcused absences

STUDYING PLAN DURING CLASS

1. Bring math homework daily
2. If all math homework is up to date you must bring other study materials
3. If all homework is complete a book is needed to keep busy the entire class time.
